


Ob under (9)




UCONN OB Under vs. Man Defense

#5 breaks out to the right FT line elbow area to receive the pop pass from #1.

As this pass is in flight, #4 is ducking in the lane and looking to seal his defender.


On the catch, #5 immediately looks inside to #4.



UCONN OB Under vs. Man Defense

If #4 is not open, #3 is setting a down screen for the inbounder, #1. #1 breaks out to the left wing while #3 screens and clears out.

#5 passes the ball to #1 on the left wing.



UCONN OB Under vs. Man Defense

If #5 could not get the ball to #4 it may have been because he was being fronted by his defender.

The quick swing pass to #1 on the left wing will allow for #4 to seal his defender for the quick post entry pass and shot.
