
## Illinois Ob under vs. man (8)




Illinois OB Under vs. Man Defense

#1 starts the play by backscreening for #5 near the freethrow line area.

#5 cuts to the basket while #4 moves in to "pick the picker" and sets a screen for #1 to break to the right wing area.

#2 will first look for #5 inside and then to #1 on the right wing.

#5 will cut to the left block area if he does not receive the ball.




Illinois OB Under vs. Man Defense

If #5 did not receive the ball, #2 passes to #1 on the right wing.

As soon as #1 has the ball, #5 is breaking up to the top of the key area towards the right wing to set a ballscreen for #1.

#2 steps in and sets a backscreen for #4 who breaks to the left low block area.

#1 comes off the ball screen and looks to feed #4 inside on the low block.



Illinois OB Under vs. Man Defense

If #4 does not receive the ball, #2 continues his movement up to the top and sets a backscreen for #5 who just completed a ballscreen with #1.

This "pick the picker" action between #2 and #5 could free him up for a lob pass to the basket from #1.
