
Kansas Ob under vs. man (2)




Kansas OB Under vs. Man

(#4) and (#5) set a double screen for (#2).

(#2) splits the middle of the screen.

(#1) enters to (#2) on the ball side wing / corner area.




Kansas OB Under vs. Man

(#4) and (#5) break out to their respective spots on the perimeter.

(#3) moves down to the block.

(#1) passes to (#4) who passes to (#5).



Kansas OB Under vs. Man

(#1) steps in to the opposite side wing area.

(#5) passes to (#1).

(#3) back screens for (#4).


(#1) can look to hit (#4) on the block.



Kansas OB Under vs. Man

If (#4) is not open, (#5) after passing to (#1), sets a down screen for (#3), creating good pick the picker action. (#1) will then look for (#3) for the shot at the top of the key area.



Kansas OB Under vs. Man

(#3) now has the ball on top and Kansas is in their 3 out 2 in alignment. They will run their motion offense or passing game from here.
