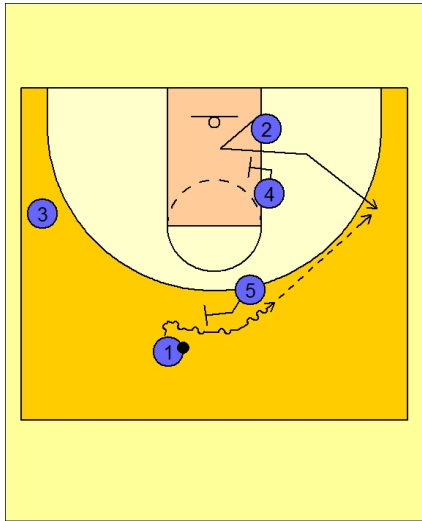




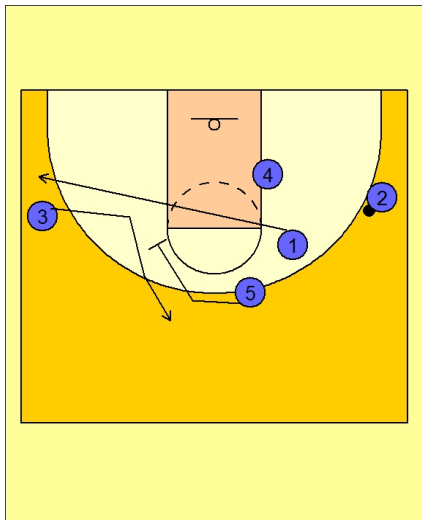
**Set play (19)**



**Kansas Set Play vs. Man Defense**

#1 and #5 execute and screen and roll on top to start the play. As that is happening, #4 is screening in for #2 to get open on the right wing.

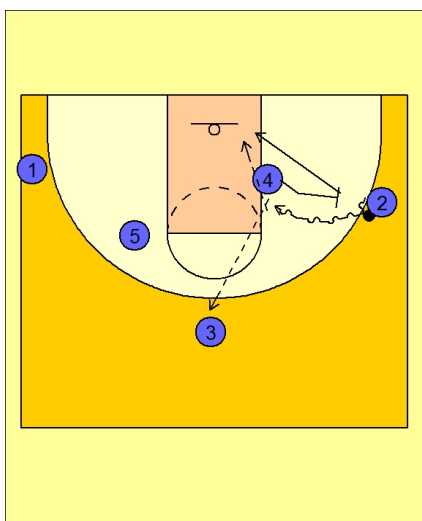
#1 looks to create and score if he can off the ball screen from #5. If not shot, he will kick to #2 on the right wing.



**Kansas Set Play vs. Man Defense**

#1 cuts to the opposite wing area.

#5 screens away for #3 cutting to the top.



**Kansas Set Play vs. Man Defense**

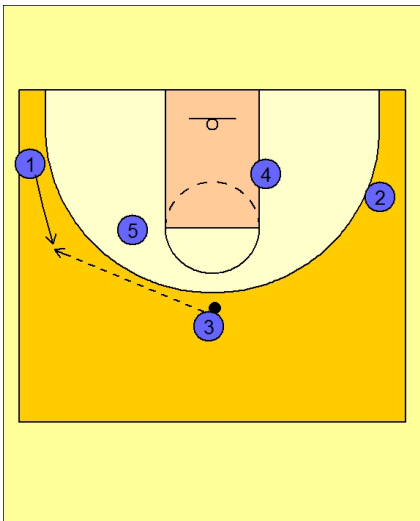
#4 and #2 now play pick and roll basketball on the right wing.

If #2 cannot score or dump the ball to #4 rolling, he will kick the ball back out on top to #3.



**Kansas Set Play vs. Man Defense**

#3 now swings the ball to #1 moving up on the left wing.



**Kansas Set Play vs. Man Defense**

#1 and #5 now play pick and roll basketball on the left wing. #3 clears away.

#1 looks to score or pass the ball to #5 rolling to the basket.

Kansas tried this early in the first half but the lob pass to the rolling #5 man was intercepted by Kentucky.

They tried it again about half way through the first half and got a dunk off of it.
