

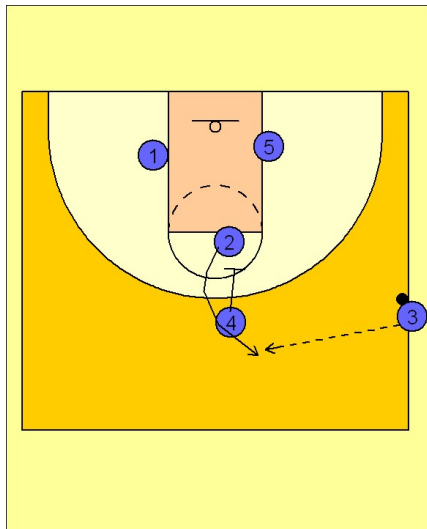

Kansas Side OB Play vs. Man

Simple yet very effective play from the Jayhawks. #4 down screens for #2 at the free throw line area. #2 breaks out to receive the entry pass from #3.

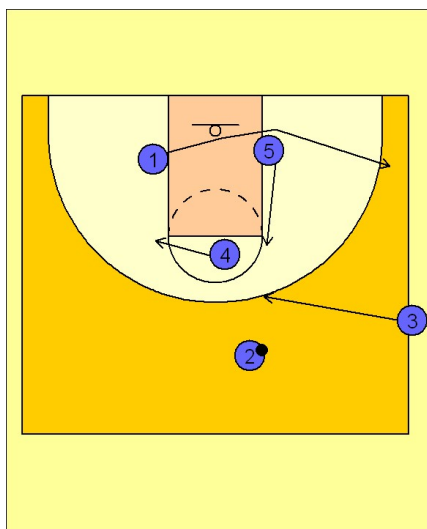

Kansas Side OB Play vs. Man

Once #2 has the ball on top, Kansas slides into their set play positions or half court offense positions. #5 moves up to the high post area while #4 moves over to the other high post elbow area. #1 comes out to the right wing. #3 cuts into the court cutting across as if to get in his position on the left wing.

All of these movements give the "illusion" as if Kansas is "jogging" into their spots on the floor ready to execute a half court offense or a set play. It does put the defense back on their heels a bit.

Kansas Side OB Play vs. Man

As #3 moves over he cuts hard off a back screen from #4 looking for the lob pass from #2. It is an intentionally slow developing play with a "quick hitting" finish for the lob.
