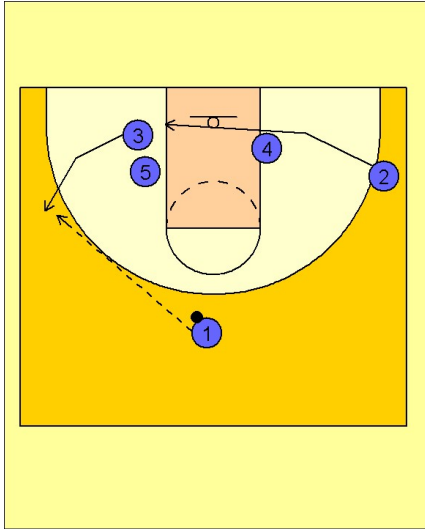

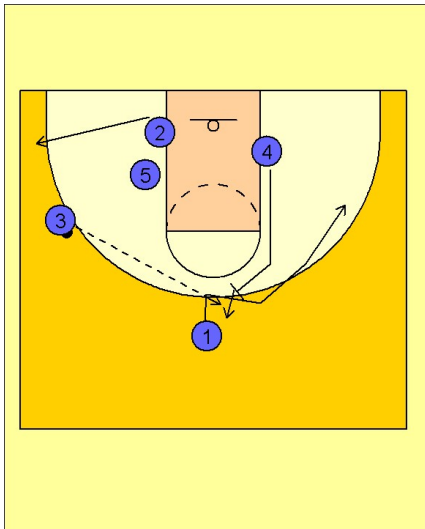


Kentucky Half Court Offense

Just another different look for Kentucky to get into their flex offense.

#3 breaks out to the left wing to receive the entry pass from #1. #2 cuts under the basket to the left low block area.

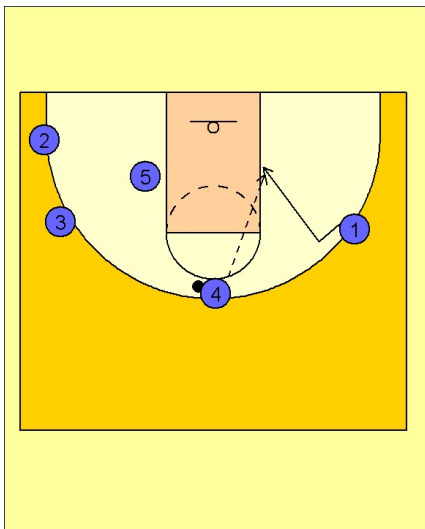

Kentucky Half Court Offense

#1 passes to #3 on the left wing and receives a back screen from #4. #1 cuts to the back side of the court looking for the skip pass from #3. #2 steps out to the left wing / corner area as this action is taking place.

Kentucky Half Court Offense

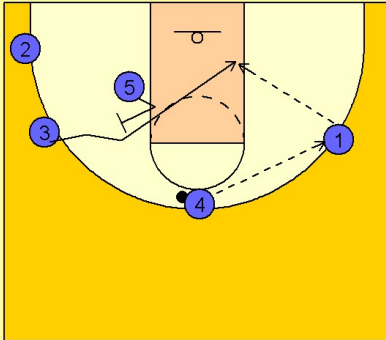
#4 steps out after screening for #1 and receives the pass from #3. #1 may look to make a quick back door cut at this time.

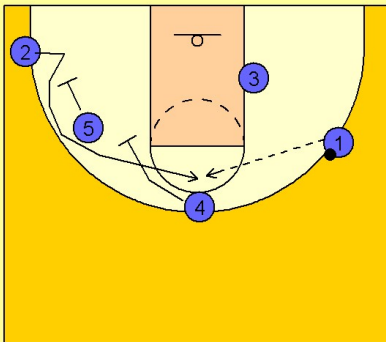
Kentucky Half Court Offense



#4 then passes to #1 on the right wing. #5 back screens for #3, who cuts into the lane to the ball side low block looking for the pass from #1.

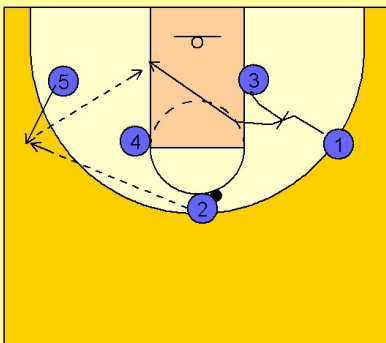
Kentucky Half Court Offense



If #3 does not receive the ball, #5 and #4 are setting a double staggered screen away for #2, who will get open on top to receive the next pass from #1 and potential open shot.

Kentucky Half Court Offense

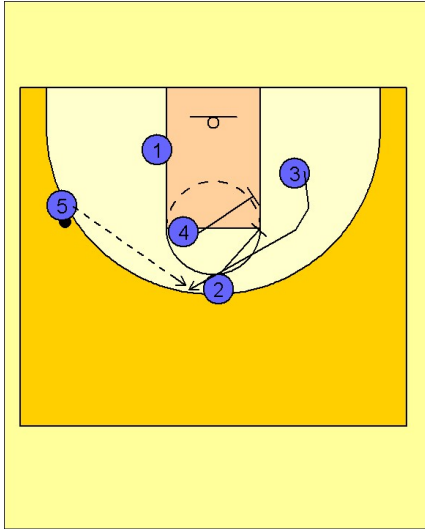


#2 now looks to reverse the ball to #5 on the left wing area. When this happens, #3 steps out and back screens for #1. #1 cuts into the lane looking for the entry pass from #5.

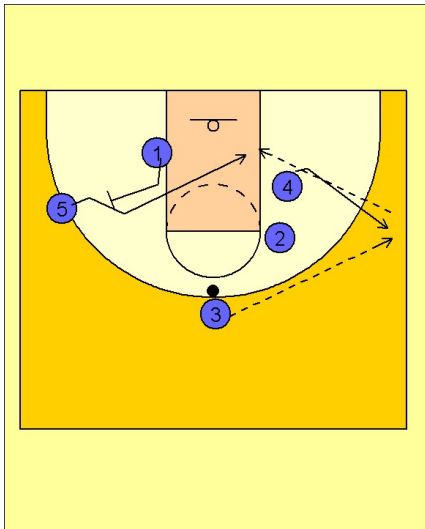

Kentucky Half Court Offense

#4 and #2 now set the double screen away for the screener, #3. #5 passes the ball to #3 on top.

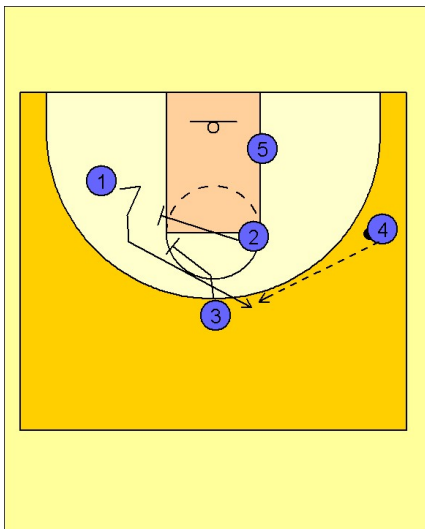

Kentucky Half Court Offense

#4 pops out and #3 passes to #4 on the right wing. As this happens, #1 back screens for #5 who cuts through the lane looking for the entry pass from #4 on the right low block.

Kentucky Half Court Offense

The offense continues as usual with #2 and #3 now setting the double screen away for #1 who comes to the top.
