



#1 reverses the ball to #5 on top who then passes to #2 on the right wing.


#4 steps out and back screens for #1 who cuts to the ball side low block area.

Once #1 cuts through, #4 and #5 set double staggered picks for #3 breaking to the top of the key.

#2 hits #3 on top.


Once #3 has it, #4 and #5 set another double staggered screen, this time for #1 coming underneath looking to get open on the left wing area.



Another option Louisville uses is for #4 to set a single screen for #1 while #5 moves across the lane to the lower block area on the right side. #3 hits #1 with a pass.

Then, #4 and #5 set double staggered screens for #2 as he cuts across the baseline looking to get open in the corner to receive the pass from #1 for a perimeter jumper.
