
Louisville Quick hitter (2)






Similar play from the last quick hitter (1), with a different scoring option at the end.

Again, (#1) reverses the ball to (#2) who passes to (#3) on the wing. Both players cut to the basket off the back screen from (#5) at the free throw line. (#1) cuts to the ball side block while (#2) cuts to the opposite block.




Louisville Quick Hitter

Instead of (#5) coming over for a ball screen, he steps out after screening to receive a pass from (#3).

At that time, (#3) and (#4) down screen for (#2) and (#1) on the block. (#5) can hit either player coming off the screen for a jump shot.

(#5) also has the option, and Louisville uses this a lot, to use a dribble hand off to either player coming off the screen.

Here we see (#5) taking it to the right side and player (#1) coming off the down screen from (#3). (#5) and (#1) perform a dribble hand off with (#1) taking the ball into the lane looking to create and score or dish off if he draws help.
