
Missouri Ob under vs. man (2)




Missouri OB Under vs. Man

Excellent OB play from Missouri. Some really good action that flows nicely into their motion offense and post opportunities.

#4 and #5 are stacked on the ball side low block. At the start, #5 breaks out to the ball side corner while #4 breaks out to the ball side wing area. #2 moves across and sets a screen for #3 to curl over the top and straight down the lane cleared out by #4 and #5. #1 can look for his first option #3 if he is open.


Great action to get it started.



Missouri OB Under vs. Man

If #3 is not open, #1 quickly enters to #5 in the corner who passes to #4 on the ball side wing. #2, after screening for #3 to start, breaks out on top.

#1 steps in and stacks up with #3 on the ball side low block.



Missouri OB Under vs. Man

#4 reverses the ball to #2 on top. #2 takes the ball over to the right side with a few dribbles while #5 cuts hard over the top of the double screen from #3 and #1. #2 can look to hit #5 if he is open.





Missouri OB Under vs. Man

If #5 is not open, #4 down screens after #5 has cut through. #4 looks to screen #1 while #3 cuts out to the corner.

#2 hits #1 on top if he is open.



Missouri OB Under vs. Man

Once #1 has the ball, he looks to #4 ducking into the post or he can hit #3 on the ball side corner for a better passing angle into the post if #4 is being played on the high side.

#5 can also flash into the high post area for the high / low post entry option. Missouri will get into their motion offense for the rest of the shot clock.
