




(#1) enters to (#3) and clears out to the opposite wing.



Michigan State Quick Hitter

When (#3) receives the pass, (#5) and (#4) set screens on the blocks for (#2) coming to the opposite corner. As this is happening, (#3) is driving the ball into the middle looking for a scoring opportunity for himself or (#2) coming off the screens.

If he can't find any openings, he keeps his dribble alive and backs the ball out to the top of the key.



Michigan State Quick Hitter

(#4) and (#5) will duck in hard in the post looking for the ball from (#3). They will usually run motion offense from here, but could run another set play.
