

Zone offense set play (2)

Michigan State Zone Offense Set Play

This play will be effective assuming your post player can shoot the perimeter shot.

(#2) reverses the ball to (#1) on top.

(#3) moves down to the block area and sets a double screen with (#4) for (#5) coming out to the opposite wing for a 3-point shot.

(#1) takes the ball over on the dribble looking for (#5). After screening, (#4) posts up and (#3) flashes to the opposite high post elbow for a jumper.

Michigan State will also run this by putting a shooter at the free throw line and moving one of the post players out to the wing. When the ball is reversed, the shooter that started at the FT line would curl underneath and come out to the wing area of the screen from (#4).
