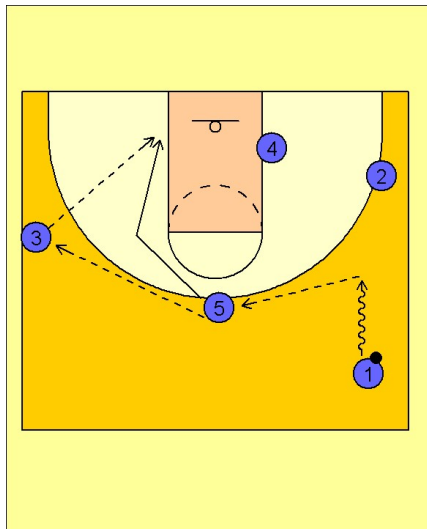

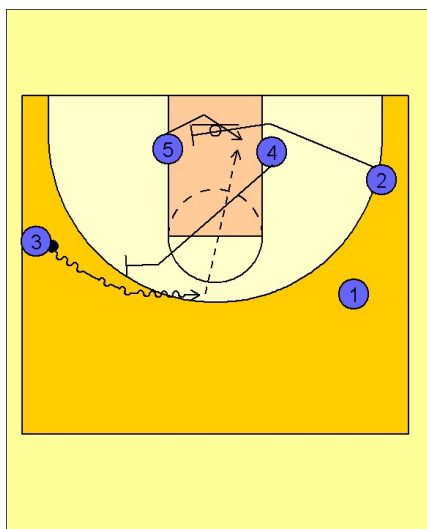


North Carolina Early Offense

#1 drives the ball up the sideline.

#1 reverses the ball to #5 on top. #5 passes to #3 on the left wing and then cuts down to the ball side low block.

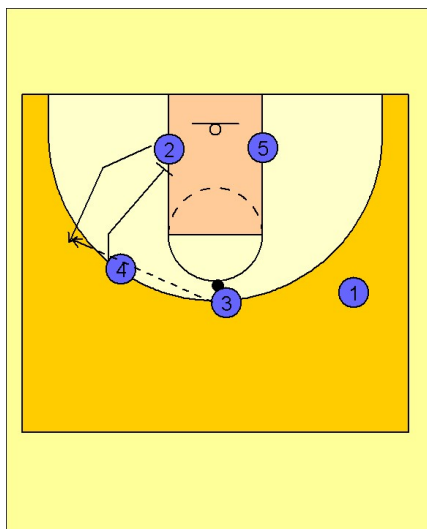


North Carolina Early Offense

#4 now moves up to set a ball screen for #3. As #3 comes off the ball screen from #4, #2 moves in the lane and sets a pick for #5. This small on big screen is effective, especially if they decide to switch defenders, giving you a size advantage.

#3 looks to score off the ball screen for dump it down low to #5.

If #5 is not open, #4 now downscreens for #2. #3 looks to hit #2 popping out to the left wing.

### North Carolina Early Offense

If #2 is being guarded closely off the downscreen from #4, #3 may elect to drive the ball at the wing player #2 and execute a dribble hand-off.
