


North carolina Early offense (3)



North Carolina Early Offense

Similar to Kansas, North Carolina uses this early offense right out of transition.

- (#1) brings the ball up the right side and reverses the ball to the trailing (#4) man.
- (#4) passes to (#3).
- (#5) follows the ball to the block.
- (#2) moves into the middle and sets a back screen on (#4's) defender.
- (#4) goes to the rim for the lob.



North Carolina Early Offense

If the lob is not there, (#3) takes the ball on the dribble to the middle of the floor. (#2), who just set the back screen for (#4), replaces (#3) on the perimeter.

As (#3) brings the ball in the middle, (#4) sets a cross screen for (#5). (#3) looks to feed (#5) coming off the screen if he is open.

They will run their motion offense or passing game from here.
