

## Oklahoma Quick hitter (10)



Oklahoma Quick Hitter vs. Man Defense


1 - 4 high to begin.

#1 drives at a wing player to begin the quick hitter.

Here we see #1 drive at #2. #2 cuts down into the lane and sets a double staggered screen with #5 for #3.

#3 breaks out to the ballside wing area looking for the potential open shot.

After #3 comes off the screen from #2, #2 turns around and uses the screen from #5 to break to the ballside corner area.



Oklahoma Quick Hitter vs. Man Defense

Most of this movement is often called "false motion", getting the defense to think about defending other things while the offense is setting up what they really want.

Here we see the floor cleared out as #4 flashes to the high post. #3 will enter the ball to #4 who will look to make the high / low entry pass to #5.

There is no backside help on this play so the post player should be able to get good position to catch and score.

#4 can also look to catch and attack the cleared out basket area.
