

## Oklahoma Quick hitter (2)



Oklahoma Quick Hitter

Oklahoma likes to use this with time winding down on the shot clock or at the end of the half or game.

(#1) has the option to penetrate in the game for a shot or a dump down pass to (#4) or (#5), a drive and kick out pass to (#2) or (#3).

(#4) and (#5) do not start on the blocks. They are a few feet off and below the blocks to start. This gives (#1) a little more room to work and will give the defense a tougher help and recover situation.

It is imperative that (#2) and (#3) are aware of getting back on defense. A good rule of thumb would be for the opposite side wing player to float back on defense when (#1) penetrates.
