


Oklahoma Quick hitter (4)

I watched Oklahoma use this in a late game situation, and I don't know if it was a play by design, but it surely worked to free up the dribbler and provided a very interesting approach to ball screening.

(#5) uses a dribble hand off with (#1).



Oklahoma Quick Hitter

As soon as (#1) receives the ball, (#5) turns around and sets a ball screen for (#1) who comes back the other direction off the screen and into the lane. This was extremely difficult to defend because of how quickly the defenders had to decide on how to guard the hand off followed up by an immediate ball screen.

(#1) can then look to drive all the way to the basket or dump it off to (#3) or (#4).
