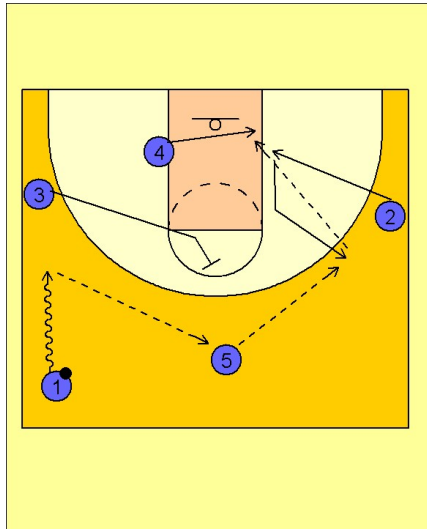


# Oklahoma state

## Early offense (5)

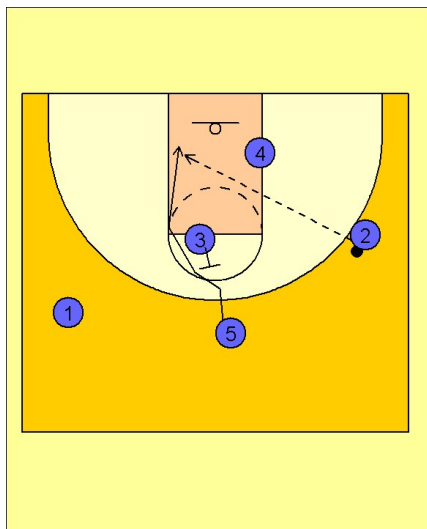
### Oklahoma State Early Offense

#1 drives the ball up the sideline. #1 then reverses the ball to #5 on top. As #1 was driving the ball up the left sideline, #2 on the opposite sideline was taking his man down towards the right low block area.

As the ball is reversed, #2 steps up the lane and then breaks out to receive the next pass on the right wing from #5. #2 looks for #4 on the right block, who has just followed the ball across the lane.

As the ball is reversed to the top man #5, #3 moves in to set up for a back screen for #5.

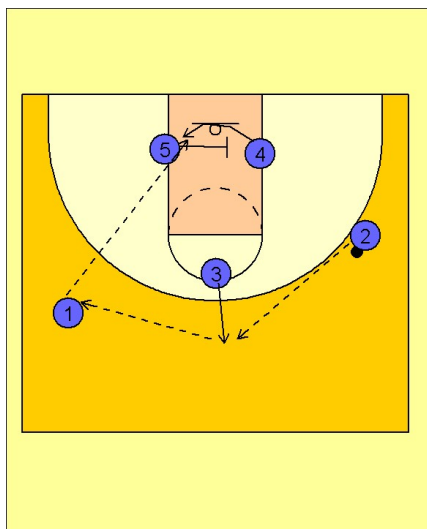

### Oklahoma State Early Offense

Once #5 passes to #2 on the right wing, #5 uses the back screen from #3 and looks for the lob pass to the rim from #2.

### Oklahoma State Early Offense

After screening, #3 pops out to receive the pass from #2.

#3 catches and reverses the ball to #1 on the left wing. As this action is happening, #5 screens across for #4. #1 will look to feed #4 on the left low block.
