

St. joes Set play vs. man (2)




St. Joe's Set Play vs. Man

#1 passes to #2 on the wing and then goes and gets the ball back from #2. #3 moves across the lane to ball side block.



St. Joe's Set Play vs. Man

#2 then breaks across the top using back screens from #5 and #4. #1 will look to skip the ball across the floor to #2 for the shot.



St. Joe's Set Play vs. Man

Once #2 gets the ball he can look to drive to the basket or he can look for #3 coming off a double down screen from #4 and #5. #4 will shape up in the post after screening for a potential post up opportunity.



St. Joe's Set Play vs. Man

If #2 isn't open for the skip pass from #1, #3 will still use the double down screen from #4 and #5 trying to get open on the top for a shot. If #3 doesn't have the shot, he can look to drive the gap towards #2 looking for a drive and kick out shot opportunity for #2 in the corner.
