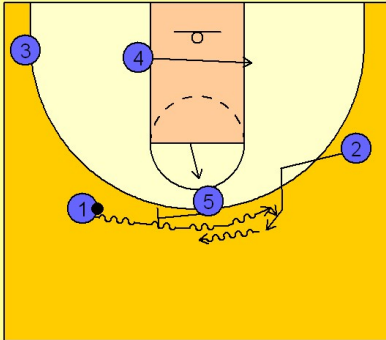

Texas Half Court Offense vs. Man Defense



The dribble weave offense is becoming more and more popular. Michigan State used it quite a bit in the past few years.

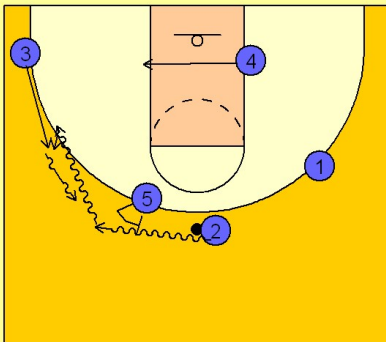
Texas has gone to it a few times this season. The perimeter players execute dribble hand offs on top with the post player stepping out to set ball screens for the dribbler.

Here we see #1 taking the ball over the top of #5's ball screen while #2 is starting to come towards the dribbler, #1, for the hand off.

The low post player, #4, will follow the ball from side to side.

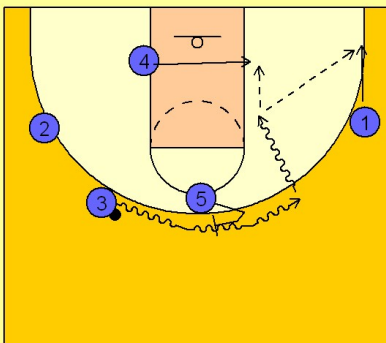
Texas Half Court Offense vs. Man Defense



As #2 gets the hand off from #1, #5 turns around and gets set to deliver another ball screen for #2 on the top. #3 begins cutting toward #2 looking for the hand off from #2.

Texas Half Court Offense vs. Man Defense



As the ball comes back the other way, again #5 turns around and sets up for the ball screen on #3.

#4 continues to follow the ball from side to side.

At any time the perimeter players can turn up towards the basket and look to penetrate as #3 is doing in this diagram. The perimeter players, #1 in this diagram, will look to spot up and look for the drive and kick out pass from the penetrating #3 man.

#4 can also look for the dump down pass if #4's defender helps up on penetration.
