




Villanova Half Court Offense vs. Man Defense

Villanova is not a team to show many looks throughout the game. They will usually stick with one alignment or "set" for the entire 40 minutes with little variation.

Here we see them use an alignment that will allow them to get quickly into a 3 out 2 in formation.


They can either have the 2 man start at the FT line and pop out or they can run him along the baseline, perhaps right out of transition to get the ball entered to a wing player.



Villanova Half Court Offense vs. Man Defense

Once the wing player receives the ball, #4 will screen across for #5, bringing him to the low block on the ball side.

After #4 screens, he pops up to the ft line and will look to catch and make the high/low pass to #5 on the block or reverse the ball to #3 on the left wing.



Villanova Half Court Offense vs. Man Defense

On ball reversal, the posts will "x" or exchange spots.



Also on ball reversal the perimeter players will either exchange or screen away. A very simple offense that will allow the talented Villanova players to take advantage of post up opportunities with no weakside help and also penetration possibilities from the top and wings.
