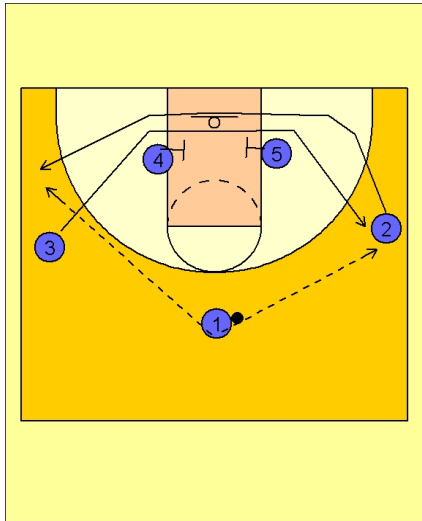




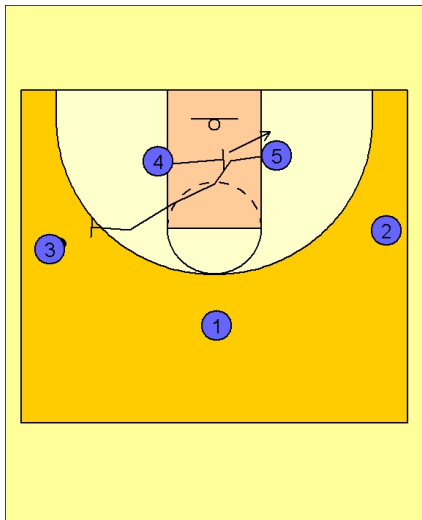
Quick hitter (5)



Villanova Quick Hitter vs. Man Defense

Play starts with #2 and #3 crossing out underneath the basket with #4 and #5 screening in for each cutter as they break out to their respective wings.

#1 will look to enter to either wing.

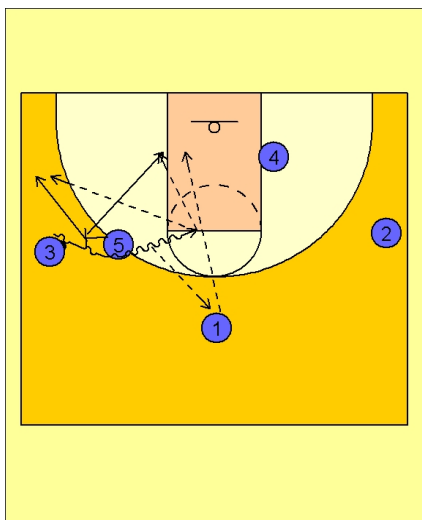


Villanova Quick Hitter vs. Man Defense

Whatever side the ball goes to, that low post player will screen across for the other post player.

Here #4 screens across for #5. This action is not intended to get #5 open in the post, rather, it is intended to slow down his defender as he cuts to the ball side wing to execute a pick and roll with #3.

A late arriving defender on the ball screen will increase the chances of scoring. #4's screen in the lane for #5 is intended to slow the post defender from getting to the ball screen hedge.



Villanova Quick Hitter vs. Man Defense

#3 and #5 now play a two-man on the left wing. #5 can roll to the basket or pop out to the perimeter if he has outside shooting skill.

#3 may also pass to #1 on top after coming off the ball screen and #1 may look to #5 rolling to the basket or popping out to the left wing / corner area.
