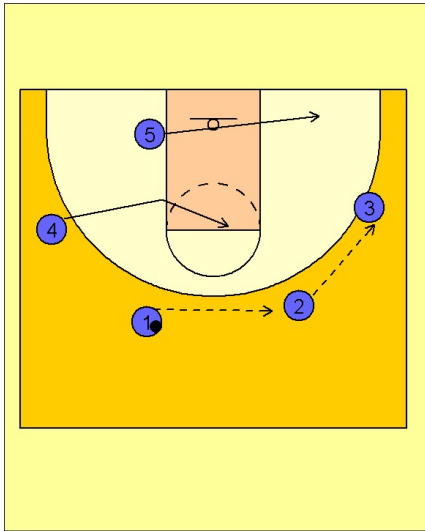


# West virginia Zone offense (1)

## West Virginia Zone Offense

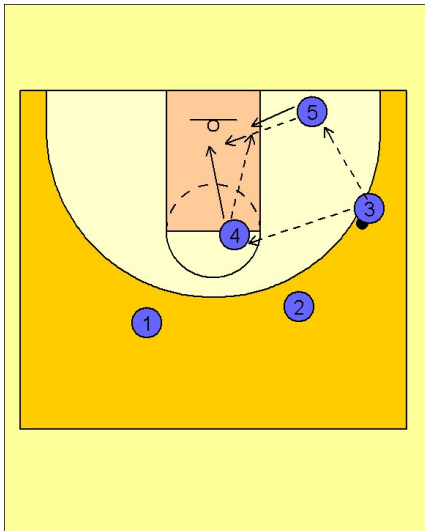


West Virginia has 4 or even 5 guys on the floor at one time who can shoot the three point shot so they run their zone offense accordingly. Usually 5 out on the perimeter with players cutting in to the post and then back out to the perimeter. They have another post player who will run the baseline looking to step short corner or to the corner when available.

Here we see #1 reverse the ball on top to #2 who passes to #3 on the right wing. #5 follows the ball across the baseline to the short corner area. The opposite wing player, #4, will flash into the middle of the lane as the ball is being reversed.

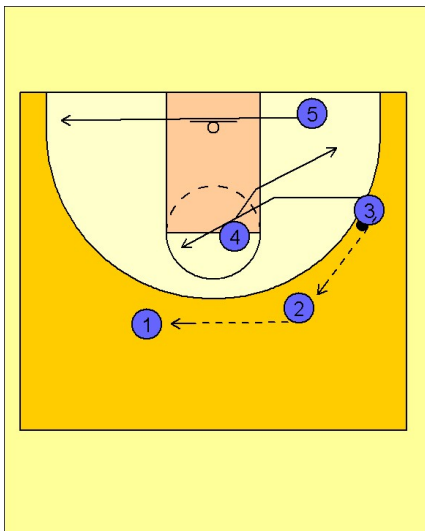
## West Virginia Zone Offense



Once #3 has the ball they will look to attack the short corner area or the high post man. If #5 receives the ball #4 will dive to the basket looking for the pass from #5. If #4 receives the ball in the high post, #5 will cut towards the basket looking for good post position.

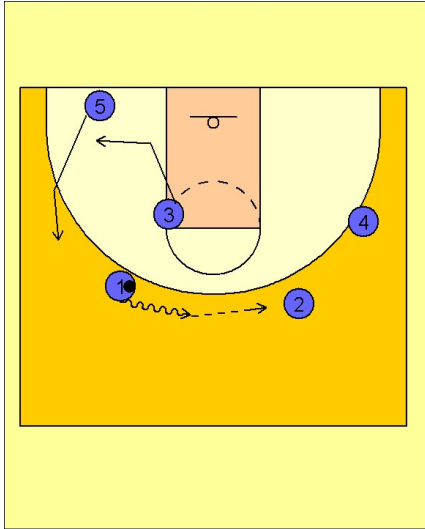
## West Virginia Zone Offense



If that is not available, #3 will reverse the ball on top to #2 who will pass to #1. #4 steps out to the right wing while #3 now cuts into the middle of the lane looking to receive the ball from #1.

#5 follows the ball across the baseline.

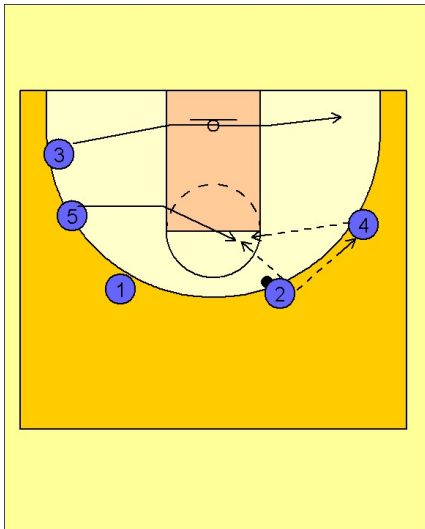

Once #1 has it he will again look in the high post to #3 or to the short corner man #5.

At any time on ball reversal, #5 may elect to slide up into the wing area while #3 moves to the corner spot.

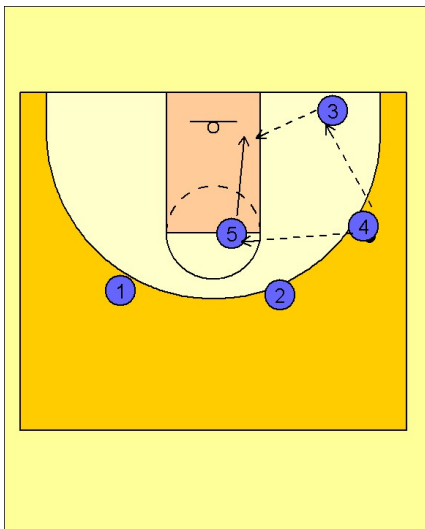

#5 now cuts into the high post area looking for the pass from #2 or #4.

#3 takes the baseline runner position and looks to catch the ball either on the short corner or in the corner.

Once #4 has the ball he will again look to the high post player #5 or to the baseline runner #3.

The movement will continue like this on ball reversal, with various wing players cutting into the middle and then back out to the perimeter and the baseline runner going to both the short corner and corner areas.
