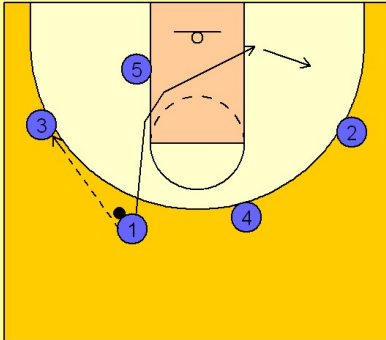

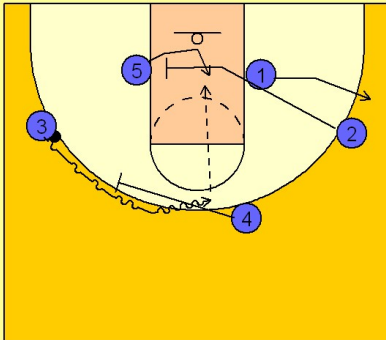
Gonzaga Early Offense



#1 enters to the left wing player #3. #1 cuts through the lane to the opposite block and then out to the opposite wing area.

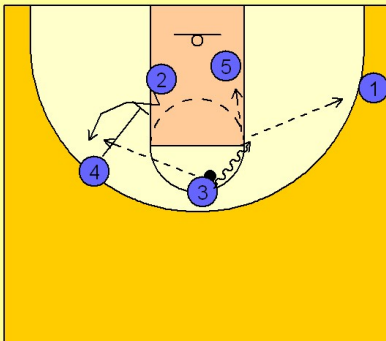
Gonzaga Early Offense



#3 then uses a ball screen from #4 who comes toward the ball. As this is happening, #2 slides into the lane and sets a screen for #5 on the block. #3 comes off the ball screen looking to turn the corner and penetrate up the middle. He is also looking for #5 coming off the screen under the basket.

Gonzaga Early Offense



If the post player #5 is not open, he may continue his penetration into the gap and look for #1 spotting up in on the wing for the shot. Also, #4, after ball screening for #3, is down screening for #2 on the block. #3 has the last option of looking for the open jump shot from #2.
