


Side-out (5)




Duke Side-Out vs. Man Defense

Box set to begin.

#3 cuts to the ball side corner area.

#5 screens across for #1.


#2 passes to #1.



Duke Side-Out vs. Man Defense

#4 steps out and back screens for #2.

#1 reverses the ball to #5 on top.




Duke Side-Out vs. Man Defense

#2 has two options here.


First, he can cut through the back screen and look for the ball.





Duke Side-Out vs. Man Defense

If that happens, #5 will sprint to the ball side low block while #4 and #1 set a double staggered screen for #3 in the right corner.



Duke Side-Out vs. Man Defense

Another great option on this play, and Duke used it for a big "3" point shot late in the game, is for #2 to fake the cut across the lane and then use a "re-screen" from #4 and cut back out to the right wing for the open jump shot.
