
Arizona Early offense (1)




Arizona has always had great point guards. Because of this, they will look to quickly ball screen for the point guard (#1) right out of their transition. (#1) will look to create off of the dribble, getting in the lane for a layup, post pass to (#5) or drive and kick out to (#2).

(#4) may also step back after the ball screen if he has 3-point range just in case the defense gets hung up defending the ball screen.



(#1) can also come off the screen looking to make a back door pass to (#2) who has set his man up and cut to the basket.

Another option they will use is to send the (#2) man all the way across the lane to set a cross screen on (#5). (#1) comes off the ball screen looking to drive and score or hit (#5) on the block.

After screening, (#4) can either screen away on the perimeter or (#3) or he can set a screen on the screener (#2) freeing him for a jump shot near the top of the key.
