
## Florida Ob side-out (1)




Florida has two options on this play. Let's take a look at the first option.

#4 back screens for #3. #3 breaks to the left wing area while #4 steps out after back screening to receive the entry pass from #1.



### Florida Side-out

#4 now has the ball and looks to hit #2 for an open shot either breaking out to the right wing off the single down screen from #5 or coming off the double staggered screen from #3 and #1 to the left wing.



### Florida Side-out


The second option would be for #4 to immediately screen down after back screening for #3 at the start of the play. #2 would break out to the top to receive the inbounds pass from #1.

Once #2 has the ball on top, #3 uses a double staggered screen along the baseline from #4 and #5 to get open on the right wing / corner area.
