


## Arizona Ob Side Out



(#4) sets a screen for (#2) and (#5) sets a screen for (#3). Both entries (either (#2 or #3) have different options. We will look first at the options if the ball is entered to (#2).

### Arizona Ob Side Out




(#4) sets a ball screen for (#2).

(#3 and #5) set up on the block for a double screen for (#1), who has inbounded the ball and is moving down near the lane to use the double screen from (#3 and #5).


## Arizona Ob Side Out



(#1) ducks under and comes out off the double screen. Depending on how he is played he can fake coming off the double and look for a quick pass underneath for a layup, or, he can curl around the double screen in the lane for a shot.

If the enter the ball to (#3) right away, they will look to post up (#5), isolated in the post. From time to time they will also pass directly into the post from out of bounds because (#3) has taken away any helpside defense by coming to the corner. If the defense fronts the post you will have a lob pass opportunity with no helpside defense. (#1) must read how they are defending the post right at the beginning of the play to use the post options.
